As a large and versatile performing arts venue in Gawler, we continually strive to bring a variety of entertaining and quality shows to the Hewitson Theatre – STARplex. Some of these we target, some of these find and book us. This was the case with Lyndall Plummer and his tribute show to Roy Orbison 'The Only One'. He was an audience member at the Johnny Cash show in August 2009 'Black – the lighter side of Johnny Cash', and immediately requested to book our Theatre for his reputable show 'The Only One – The Sounds of Roy Orbison'...he didn't disappoint.

The six piece band took the audience through Roy's lifetime for nearly three hours. Lyndall (as Roy Orbison) is the star of the show, but is backed up by his talented son Dane (just 15 years old) on lead guitar, beautiful daughter Brittney (20 years old) on backing vocals, Damien Schmidt on drums, Peter Kroehn on bass guitar and Karim on keyboard and backing vocals.

Act 1 showcased Roy's concert in Melbourne in 1994, with classics like 'Ooby Dooby', 'Only The Lonely' and 'Go Go Down The Line'. Act 2 followed the 'Black & White Night' performance of 1987 with 'Crying', 'Mystery Girl' and 'Working For The Man'. Roy's life and times with the Travelling Wilburys rounded off the fun night, with the audience up and dancing to 'You Got It', 'Pretty Woman' and 'Running Scared'.

A great night of entertainment with rolling slide show, trivia (& prizes) for the audience and a hint of possible return in October this year...so stay tuned and keep your friends primed!
